The safety of everybody attending our events is our number one priority.

We can confirm we have complied with government guidance on managing the risk of COVID-19.

Please be assured we are working with the venue and following government guidelines to ensure safety on site.

COVID-19 guidance is constantly being reviewed and we will look to follow the relevant guidance at the time, on site.

We have implemented several steps to keep everybody safe in-line with government guidance including:

CDS (Crowd Density Standard)

We will allow for the Crowd Density Standard in accordance with government guidance. By controlling the density (numbers of people on site at any one time). Appropriate social distancing will occur by consideration of both the number of people and potential pinch points to determine the number of people in that area.

Pre-registration/prebooking and Contact tracing.

Registration/prebooking plots and visitors tickets is required to enter site and pre-registration is required which can be done online via our website www.4x4sparesday.co.uk and available until end of the actual event day.

Registration is available on the day at event, card facilities and cash payments accepted (please bring correct change) but please if you can register/book tickets online prior to the event.

In accordance with Government guidelines, we are asking that everyone attending the event to assist us by taking part in the 'Track & Trace 'programme. By Pre-registering, you will already have complied.

Floor planning

Looking at solutions, such as one-way visitor traffic, will create a flow through the event. This can prevent bottlenecks in addition to cross walking, helping us to keep to the CDS guidelines at all times.

2 metre social distancing guidelines with 1 metre plus if required.

Outdoor aisle widths will be increased to 9 metres, indoors a minimum of 5 metres

Exhibitors will be given extra space on their stands to allow for social distancing on their stand

Indoor areas including halls and toilets, **all persons to wear a face mask.**

Food & Beverage

All our catering units will look to provide take away food, served pre-packaged or in closed containers.

Queueing

We will ensure any queuing areas are clearly marked with relevant social distancing.

Cleaning regime

Onsite cleaners will have an increased focus on key areas, including toilets, food and beverage areas, and help points.

We are bringing in additional mobile toilets and outdoor wash stations.

Hand sanitizer stations

Hand sanitiser stations will be positioned at key areas throughout the event, including toilets and food and beverage locations. With signage around site encouraging all on-site to use regularly.

First aid

24-hour first aid on-site for anyone needing advice.

There will be 2 quarantine rooms available on-site.

Event signage

Signage will be displayed prominently with repeat messages about the importance of maintaining physical distance and washing and sanitising hands in addition to other best practices.

Sellers/traders camping, Saturday night.

There will be limited pitches available on-site for sellers/traders only.

They will be marked out so as to leave a pitch in between each.

We encourage you to bring and use your own facilities, there will be limited toilets open on-site overnight and no showers in use throughout the whole event period.
